- SHSAT was held at Booker T. yesterday. 8th graders are relieved that it's behind them.
- Report cards will be printed/distributed this afternoon
- Discussion of CEP goals

CEP Update/Formulation of CEP Goals

Discussion of updating our CEP goals based on *specific* student growth for students (i.e. moving from a score of low 1 →a high 1).

- Determine a *specific* percentage (40%) of students who are in a specific grade level to approve.
 - Approval would be in general even just by a few points.
- Goals for students scoring 3's/4's?
 - Do we need a specific goal on the CEP list for them?
 - Would be harder for a student who received a 4 in 7th grade to get a "4" on the 8th grade regents.
- Keep in mind:
 - Percentages are affected by turnover of students at Booker T.
 - Students scoring 1's and 2's struggle with learning needs/at home situations.
 - **Proposal:** 50% of students scoring 1's and 2's on their state tests will improve their score.

High school admissions support

- Not a lot of information given to parents about applying for non-specialized high schools.
- Last year was similar parents have taken charge in the past creating lists for open houses.
- Progression every year:
 - SHSAT prep in the mornings.
- Moving forward:
 - Having alum come back in the Spring to talk to 7th grade students.
 - Finding ways to educate the parents on schools that aren't the top 10.
 - Environmental Studies/HS for Math and Science/Washington Irving
 - Parents who have been through the experience can sign up to volunteer to share information with parents currently going through the experience.

8th Grade HW Extension Policy

- Proposal to have an extension for HW when students are on high school tours.
- No official policy for extension not waiting for January to assign work. Teachers have been lite on the hw/lienet with extensions. Students should speak to their specific teacher about their scenario/need to advocate for themself.
