## PRESIDENTS' REPORT:

• Uptown Jazz Update -

**Revenue:** Through the last week, we have sold 139 tickets (\$14,200) and have just over \$20K in donated items. **Expense:** Trending \$2,000 over the \$26,650 budget submitted in October due to the expectation that we will need to hire data entry support & mobile bidding. We expect final costs within the \$30,000 allocated by the PTA. **Catering:** Anne Pejovich identified Melba's restaurant on 112<sup>th</sup> Street. We are finalizing deal terms.

**Décor:** Lisa Barry has taken the lead on layout and design. Final decisions will be made during the next two weeks. Performance: Student jazz band, Mr. Fagen playlist, Jerome slide show, DJ Greg

**Volunteers:** Sign-up Genius will be posted in coming weeks. We hope each Exec Board member will take a shift. **Event:**

- 108<sup>th</sup> Street Construction Update The contractor continues to build on schedule and the full height should be realized this spring with interiors finished in time for the first residents to move in by October 2020. We will invite Westside Federation for Supportive and Senior Housing to come to a PTA meeting this spring in order to share details and answer questions from our community. We need to identify a member of the community that can attend the Construction Advisory Group meetings as Chris and Jerome are graduating out in June. The regular monthly Construction Advisory Group meeting is the morning of February 11. There may be additional updates to be shared with the Exec Board and general PTA that come out of that meeting.
- **Field Closure** field to be closed for renovations late March through September; trying to both speed this up, and find alternative outdoor recess options including street closure
- Safety Update one of security guards is retiring in June
