Discussions:

Open School Week:

The group discussed how to organize Open School Week.

Agreed on the following approach:

- William Reinisch will set up School Bookings;
- Signup will be "per child" vs. "per family"
- Dates: Monday, Nov. 27th 1st, 2nd, 3rd period AND Wednesday, Nov. 29th 1st, 2nd period

Community Service Presentation

Building on the discussion from the Sept 2017 meeting, Katie Miller invited Natalie Silverstein to present to SLT. Natalie shared the following information:

- Doing Good Together was founded in Minneapolis and has now expanded to other cities, including NYC
- Natalie is the NYC coordinator of "Doing Good Together" www.doinggoodtogether.org Provides a central place to post volunteer opportunities for families and youth.
- Discussed the importance of incorporating volunteer work into the fabric of family. Parents should live the values, demonstrating what it is to be a good person in the world. Incorporate into the lives of children in simple ways.
- There was a large emphasis on finding meaningful community service projects that are more than just a "check the box" activity.
- The discussion around the project is just as important as the project.
- PROPOSED (PHASED) NEXT STEPS:
 - o 1st: Natalie to speak to students in November, in assembly format. She will focus on the importance of community service and how to get involved (incorporating lots of stories to deliver volunteer message; Katie suggested approaching the students with "this is your world; you can fix it" message)
 - o 2nd: Natalie will speak to the parents at a PTA meeting. She will focus on how and why your students should do community service.
 - o 3rd: Run Community Service Fair in Spring that will be student driven and reflect the ideas and interests of the students.
 - o 4th: Community Service event for the 8th graders after graduation
