FOR ALL STUDENTS

Personal Supplies:

(Some of these will be kept at home.)

- #2 pencils (including some mechanical ones)
- Blue or black pens
- Highlighters in several colors
- Colored markers
- Colored pencils
- Loose-leaf paper
- 3x5/4x6 index cards
- Glue sticks (one dozen)
- Scotch tape
- Small stapler
- White out
- 6 inch dual-sided ruler (in/cm)
- Small scissors (approx. 5 inches)
- Small pencil sharpener with cover for shavings
- One flash drive for saving computer work either at home or at school

FOR ALL STUDENTS

6th Grade Supply List

- Scientific calculator (with $\sqrt{\quad}$, π functions)
- 6 composition books (one red, one blue, one green, one yellow and 2 black)
If you cannot find composition books in these colors, do not panic, a color coded sticker will be provided to the students during the first week.)
- 1 graph composition book
- 12 double pocket folders (without center fasteners)

7th Grade Supply List

- Calculator
Preferred: Graphing calculator (TI 84 Plus)
Acceptable: Scientific calculator with π , $\sqrt{\quad}$ functions
- 6 composition books
- 2 graph composition book*
- 1 single subject spiral notebook
- 12 double pocket folders (without fasteners)
- 1 pack of graph paper (4x4 or 5x5 grid)
- 1 box (25) sheet protectors

8th Grade Supply List

- graphing calculator (TI84Plus) (required for Regents math)
- 6 composition books*
- 2 graph composition book*
- 2 single subject spiral notebooks (8 ½ x 11)
- 12 double pocket folders (without fasteners)
- 1 pack of graph paper (4x4 or 5x5 grid)

Please Note:

Students may not use rolling backpacks in the building.

We ask that you purchase the supplies for the classroom so that these are available to your children. Having the supplies available in the classroom for student use keeps the weight of the bookbags down.

The students' backpacks can be very heavy, therefore, we suggest that, if possible, you purchase composition books that are less than 100 pages. (Prioritize buying thin books over buying different colored books. Hard covered books hold up far better than flexible covered books.)

We suggest: Roaring Springs model number 77222. It is hard cover, 60 pages and durable. It is more expensive, but your child's back is worth it. It is available through Amazon.
